These tests are taken on the computer. MAP Growth tests are unique in that they adapt to be appropriate for each child's level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed. With MAP Growth tests, we can administer shorter tests and use less class time while still receiving detailed, accurate information about the students' growth. Reports will be available for parents once testing is completed. Please make sure that your child gets a good night's rest and eats a healthy breakfast during MAP Growth testing. Thank you!
