To celebrate Red Ribbon Week, these special theme days have been planned:

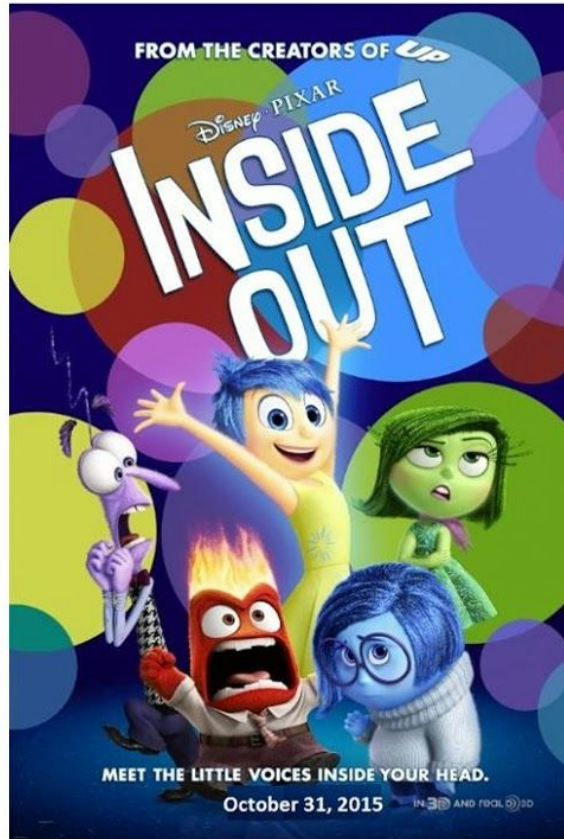
Monday, October 26th—"I'm Too Bright for Drugs" (Wear BRIGHT colors.)
