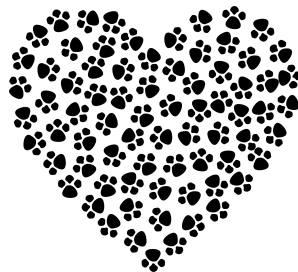

**Emphasizing the Importance of Reading**
