WEEKEND BACKPACK PROGRAM...... The Backpack Program is back! This program provides a weekend supply of nutritious food for children when school lunch and breakfast is unavailable on the weekend. Each food bag consists of 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 3 snacks, 1 can of vegetables, and 1 can of fruit. All food is nonperishable and provided to the children free of charge. It is our hope that these resources will support the health, behaviors, and achievement of every students that participates. The program is run completely by volunteers who help pack the food bags and is funded through the generous gifts of the Wayne County Food Pantry.
